



FEES

Pickup:

\$15.00

Boarding: \$10.00 first day & \$5.00 thereafter

Adoption: \$10.00

NOTES

- Strays have shelter space priority over surrendered pets.
- Animal Control does not pickup non-emergency surrenders.
- Citizen pick-ups, stray, wandering, or nuisance dogs are not considered emergency and will be picked up during normal working hours..
- Animal Control does not provide ambulatory/medical care for known owned dogs.

Nottoway County Animal Control Policy – CATS

For details on any Nottoway County Animal Control issue, call the Nottoway County Animal Shelter at (434) 292-1099.

Owned Cats:

A cat is being fed and/or sheltered by a homeowner.

Animal Control officers will not pick up.

Stray Cats:

A cat that has been abandoned or exhibits characteristics of

once being a pet.

Animal Control officers will pick up.

Feral Cats:

A cat exhibits characteristics of a wild animal.

Animal Control officers will not pick up.

Injured Cats:

A cat that is need of veterinary care.

Animal Control will not be responsible for injured / sick owned cats. Animal Control may pick up injured stray and feral cats if they can be

caught.

Surrendered Cats:

Owned cats brought to the shelter to transfer responsibility

to Nottoway County Animal Control.

Animal Control will not accept injured / sick surrendered cats. Owner will be responsible and may be subject to citation if proper care is not

administered.

Animal Control will only accept surrendered cats if space is available

in the Nottoway County Animal Shelter.
