      - Divulge all known health problems
      - Distemper booster for dogs under 6 months if time is applicable (Avoids having to start the series over)
    - Nice to Have
      - 4DX ( only if included in pull fee )
      - Fecal test (only included in the pull fee)
      - Microchip (only if included in the pull fee)
      - Spay/Neuter
      - Treatment Other including dental,
      - Deworming if no vet appointment needed
      - Preventatives
      - Video of dog on dog interaction (preferred)
  - Cats -
    - Required
      - FIV/FeLV Test
      - Rabies Vaccine
      - FVRCP Vaccine
      - Divulge all known health problems
    - Nice to Have
      - Around 6 months FVRCP booster
      - Spay/Neuter
      - Treatment Other including dental,
      - Deworming if no vet appointment needed

- What Behavior
  - Bonded animals considered case by case
  - Leash able to walk comfortably on a leash
  - Dog reactivity preferably dog friendly, no history of aggression, fighting or killed other dog/cat
  - People reactivity friendly to humans, not aggressive, able to be easily removed from kennel run
  - Bite Records description of bite required, considered on a case by case

- Socialized -
  - Kittens or cats are able to be held and purr, not hissing when human reaches to them, must be hand friendly
  - Dogs able to be handled by humans and not overall shut down and afraid
- Cats preferred cats that are ok in communal setting if at all possible
- Feral no feral animals
- How much will we spend?
  - We will consider intake fees per animal based on medical treatments completed on intake
  - Negotiated with each rescue partner

- What Age
  - Cats -
    - Primarily under 8 years old, consider older on case by case basis
    - Foster care required for kittens 10 months or younger or under the weight x lbs
    - Pregnant momma cats considered on case by case basis
  - Dogs -
    - Primarily under 8 years old, consider older on case by case basis
    - Primarily 6 months and older, under this age requires foster care and special coordination
