The primary programming of Animal Resources of Tidewater is providing veterinary care for beloved pets whose owners cannot afford such care and, without which the pet might suffer or be euthanized, or surrendered to a shelter. Animal Resources also provides free spay-neuter for owned pets and community cats. Both of these initiatives are aimed at reducing shelter intake and increasing the save rate for sheltered pets. Rarely, ART takes in animals from the public and other releasing agencies. Animal Resources of Tidewater is committed to saving the lives of homeless animals, with a focus on utilizing our resources to maximize the life-saving of companion animals to the greatest extent possible.
