Mecklenburg County, Virginia Animal Intake Policy

Intake of Stray Dogs

- 1. Call comes in to 911 Dispatch, County Office, or Animal Control Officer.
- 2. Animal Control Officer picks up dog.
- 3. Complainant signs call sheet.
- 4. Animal Control Officer fills out custody sheet.
- 5. Animal Control Officer puts dog in shelter for 12 days if it has a collar and 7 days if it does not have a collar.
- 6. After hold time is up, if the dog is adoptable, Animal Control tries to adopt the dog out or find a rescue shelter to take the dog.
- 7. After hold time is up, if the dog is not an adoptable or if the Animal Control Officer cannot find someone to adopt the dog or a rescue shelter to take the dog, the Animal Control Officer transports the dog to a veterinarian to be euthanized.

Intake of Dogs due to owner surrender

- 1. Call comes in to 911 Dispatch, County Office, or Animal Control Officer.
- 2. Animal Control Officer picks up dog.
- 3. Animal Control Officer fills out custody sheet.
- 4. Owner signs custody sheet.
- 5. Dog is put in shelter for 4 days.
- 6. After hold time is up, if the dog is adoptable, Animal Control tries to adopt the dog out or find a rescue shelter to take the dog.
- 7. After hold time is up, if the dog is not an adoptable or if the Animal Control Officer cannot find someone to adopt the dog or a rescue shelter to take the dog, the Animal Control Officer transports the dog to a veterinarian to be euthanized.

NOTE: Animal Control Officers do not pick up cats, stray or owner surrender, except in the case of a bite or injured cat.
