

RAINBOW ANIMAL RESCUE INTAKE PROCEDURE

Dogs are rescued by:

1. Owner surrender (a release must be completed before any dog is accepted)
2. Taken from an animal control or SPCA- records must be submitted
3. Strays- must first notify animal control with the dog's information and picture or taken directly to animal control

NOTE: We will only accept dogs if we have a suitable foster and the monetary funds to fully vet

All dogs must be logged into the Intake form and tagged with an identification tag. This is a tracking form that takes the dog from intake to adoption. All records will be maintained permanently.

Once rescued, they are to be fully vaccinated, have blood work to include 4DX, fecal, and other health issues addressed. Once this is completed, they are taken to their foster home.

They are added to Rainbow's website to include all information known to Rainbow and a photo
