INTAKE POLICY

Lake Country SPCA is a no-kill shelter and works closely with area animal control facilities to save as many animals as possible. Our policy is to take in as many dogs and cats as we are able to house without over-crowding our shelter. We do not accept vicious dogs or feral cats. We have a good rate of adoptions. We transfer a large number of animals to other facilities in the state so they have a better chance of getting a forever home. Our animals are examined upon arrival at our facility, given all necessary vaccines, flea and tick treatments, treated for worms and given baths. Any animal that needs medical attention is taken to our vet immediately for an examination. Sick animals are kept in isolation until well enough to be introduced into the general population. When we receive strays, we notify Animal Control and hold them for ten days before they are available for adoption. Animal Control also holds dogs for us until we have room to accept them.
