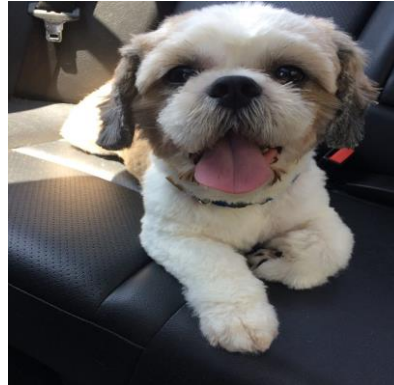

Ethel arrived to the rescue with Bladder Cancer.

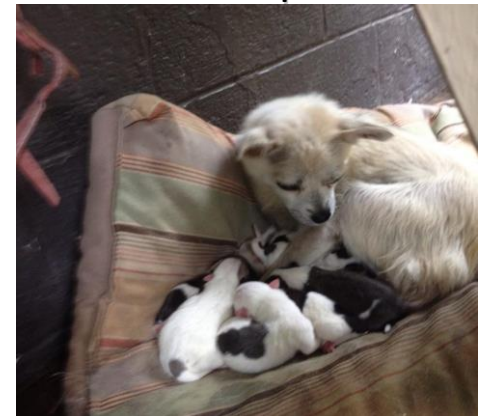


George and Jane came in from a shelter down south with heartworms.



Puppy Love and Spaying and Neutering

Our puppies are so cute! Puppies need all of their initial vetting and vaccinations and can be a handful! HHARG saves pregnant dogs, mama dogs with unweaned puppies and litters of puppies from high-kill shelters. HHARG fosters these until all are adopted!
