Intake Policy

Madison Community Cats has limited foster home capacity, therefore we only intake kittens and young friendly cats from our Trap/Neuter/Return locations in Madison and Culpeper Counties. Exceptions are orphan kittens, neonatal kittens, sick or injured kittens and in rare situations sick or injured adult cats. Since we have a limited adoption program, we transfer the majority of cats and kittens to larger no-kill rescues, humane societies and shelters after they have been through our foster program and are spayed/ neutered and vaccinated.
