

The Furever Project's Animal Intake Policy

The Furever Project is a foster-based rescue. The number of dogs we can have in our custody at any one time is determined by the availability of suitable foster homes for the dog(s). All foster families are volunteers and may refuse any dog(s) they do not think will be a good fit in their home. Every dog(s) we consider taking into the custody of The Furever Project is given a full temperament test prior to being taken in by Furever. We do not take in dog(s) that have a known history of aggression.

Any private individual surrendering an animal to The Furever Project must complete and sign a Furever Project Dog Transfer of Ownership form which gives full legal custody of the animal(s) to The Furever Project.

Any Furever Project representatives receiving animals from another releasing agency will sign a document indicating that The Furever Project assumes full legal custody of the animal(s).
