

Animal Intake Policy

Compact Canine Rescue will accept dogs from a shelter or owner if the following criteria are met:

- The dog must be less than 20 pounds (but will consider larger dogs on an as needed basis)
- The dog can be any breed as long as it fits the weight requirement
- The rescue does not take dogs with a known unprovoked bite history
- The rescue will take dogs with bite history if
 - ◆ It is known the skin was broken
 - ◆ It is known the dog was provoked
 - ◆ It is known the dog was being abused
 - ◆ It is known the dog was scared
 - ◆ An explanation can be given
 - ◆ It is at the discretion of the Intake Coordinator and the Board
- The rescue does not shy away from medical cases if funds are available
- If there is a foster home available with the appropriate skills to handle the dog in foster care
- It is our intent to adopt the dog out within 12 weeks pending medical issues
- The rescue will only humanely euthanize as a last resort when all other medical and/or behavioral treatments fail
