

Their Voice Limited Animal Intake Policy

We strive to take in as many animals as we can as most of our animals are found as strays. We strongly recommend spay,neuter, and microchipping your pet

- 1. Temperament test the the animal, Behavior assessment is done by Their Voice Limited Intake Coordinator and the Veterinary the rescue uses. (Dogs that do not pass temperament testing are not released to rescue.)**
- 2. Tag the animal. Every animal will get his/her unique number. This number will stay with animal during rescue.**
- 3. Hold**
Every animal will be on a 10 day hold. Gives animal time to decompress and personality come out
- 4. Forever process- after vetting rescue can start advertising for animals forever home**

Intake steps when a animal is found as a stray:

- 1. Report the dog to the Animal Control Officer (ACO).**
- 2. Unless the owner is found and wants the animal back, the animal typically remains with TVL in a foster home until ACO formally releases the dog to TVL.**
- 3. The animal is vet-checked by Their Voice Limited (TVL) -approved veterinarian soon after arriving at the foster home.**

Intake steps during a rescue transfer:

- 1. The rescue contacts Their Voice Limited.**
- 2. TVL contacts the rescue and sets an appointment to meet with the rescue and the animal.**
- 3. TVL performs a temperament test of the animal, if deemed necessary (the rescue may have already done a temperament test).**
- 4. The rescue completes (and signs) the Rescue Transfer Agreement.**
- 5. The animal is transferred by a TVL Representative to an TVL foster home.**
- 6. The dog is vet-checked by an TVL-approved veterinarian soon after arriving at the foster home, unless the animal's medical records show that it is current on all vaccines.**
