Rad Ranch Rescue is a no-kill animal rescue that accepts animals found stray, surrendered by owner, directly from local animal control, as a transfer from other rescue organizations, or from shelters in Virginia, Maryland, and California. Our policy is to help animals in the most dire need first. If we cannot take an animal, we will make reasonable efforts to refer the inquirer to other resources or organizations.

The rescue can be contacted via phone, email, or social media. A representative from the rescue will ask for history regarding the animal to include past veterinary care, ownership information, and behavior. An in person assessment may be scheduled as well if not enough information is available or provided. If it is deemed that our rescue can help the animal, a representative of the rescue will then schedule to pick up the animal or for the animal to be brought to the rescue. Upon intake, the animal will be examined by rescue staff and scanned for a microchip. The animal will remain quarantined until examined by a veterinarian and vaccinated.
