Animal Intake Policy

- 1. Only animals allowed belong to the genus and species Felis cati.
- 2. Only animals owned by citizens from counties of Greene, Madison and Orange will be considered.
- 3. Intakes must be done during normal hours unless other arrangements are made.
- 4. Classes of felines are;
 - a. Newborns
 - b. Nursing queens
 - c. Pregnant queens
 - d. Weaned kittens
 - e. Socialized kittens
 - f. Juveniles > 4 months
 - g. Juveniles < 4 months but > 6 months
 - h. Young adults between 6 months & 12 months
 - i. Adults over one year
 - j. Semi-feral animals
 - k. Completely feral animals
- 5. Intake policies for these classes of felines;
 - I. we will intake class's e, f, g, and h, at any time if we have space
 - II. we will not intake any animals and class in class k
 - III. we will intake animals in class j, only on Wednesday and only if we have an adopter waiting for an animal, however they must take that animal home that afternoon. This is for the safety of our staff and for the welfare of the animal
 - IV. we will not intake class a and b unless we have a foster to care for said animals
 - V. we prefer class d animals be taken care of by the person relinquishing them until they become class e animals
 - VI. class k animals will be euthanized unless the presenter agrees to take them home after they have been spayed or neutered, vaccinated and ear tipped
 - VII. we must intake animals abandoned on our door step, depending on the class, we will either, admit to our facility, send to a foster person or euthanize them
 - VIII. animals in the j class are considered in a case by case basis depending on their demeanor
 - IX. class c animals are to be considered, depending on their stage of gestation and physical condition, which could include; foster ,spay or adopt outright
 - X. no animals will allowed to be adopted, unless they have been spayed or neutered
 - XI. any sick or malnourished animal will be dealt with on a case by case basis
